Airstream Travel Trailer Departure Checklist



Outside

- Turn off exterior lighting
- Dump tanks
- Fill fresh water tank
- Close gray tank valves
- Disconnect and stow service lines
- Lock storage compartments
- Check generator oil level
- Check battery water levels
- Inspect electrical cords
- Check fluid levels: fuel, transmission, DEF, brake, coolant, windshield washer, power steering
- Ensure LP tank valve is closed
- Ensure stabilizing jacks are fully retracted
- Check hitch and coupler for proper attachment
- Check safety chains and breakaway switch cable
- Fully retract hitch jack; remove and stow jack stand or wood block
- Check all marker lights, taillights, clearance lights, brake lights
- Check lug nuts
- Check TPMS monitor
- Check windows and mirrors
- Check smoke alarm and CO detector
- Check your awning is retracted
- Test brakes
- Pull forward, stop, park, and double check your hitch set up
- Check for garbage or debris
- Check back up camera
- Secure second set of keys

Inside

- Securely stow all of your camping gear and goods. Do not overload.
- Bag trash for disposal
- Close windows
- Close vents
- Lock all interior cabinet doors
- Latch refrigerator door
- Turn off HVAC
- Latch TV for travel
- Lower TV antenna
- Turn interior lights off
- Fasten sliding doors by turning travel lock inward
- Ensure that master battery disconnect switch is "OFF"
- Turn off water pump, relieve pressure at faucet and heater
- Remove water from toilet bowl, lower lid
- Stow table
- Lower blinds
- Secure hall dividers
- Pull up or retract step
- Secure and Lock main door
- Lock dead bolt
